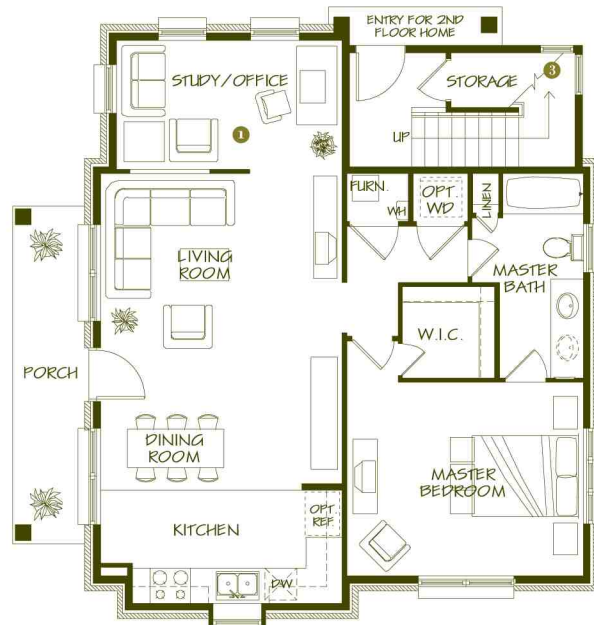
- 1 Here's something else you don't usually get with a condo — a study.
